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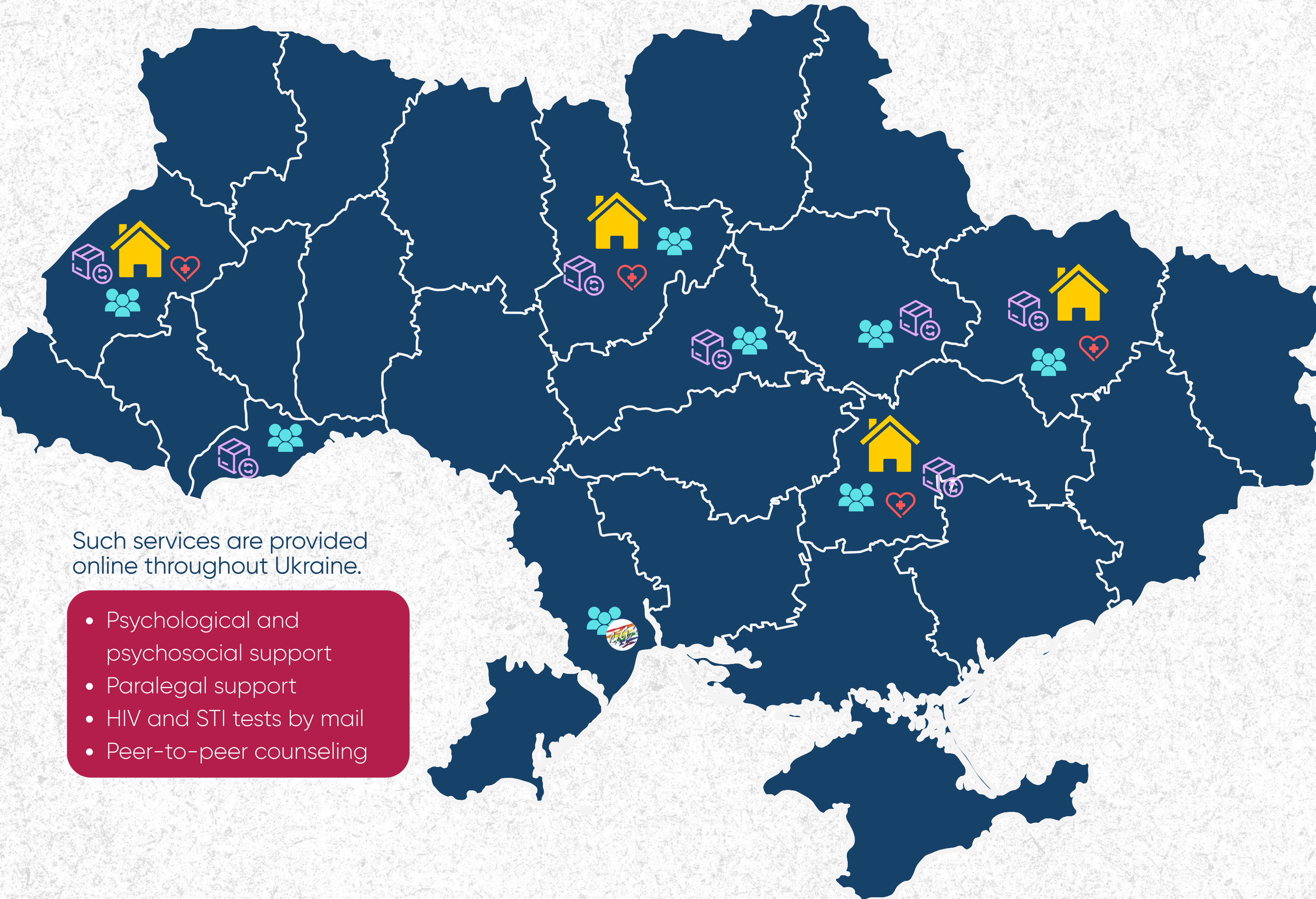


About us

ALLIANCE.GLOBAL, Public Organization (hereinafter PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL") **specializes** in protecting human rights and promoting the reduction of homo-, bi-, and transphobia in Ukrainian society; providing services for HIV/AIDS, viral hepatitis, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) among men who have sex with men (MSM), and is focused on **the development and consolidation of the LGBTIQ+ community.**

Officially registered in **October 2002**



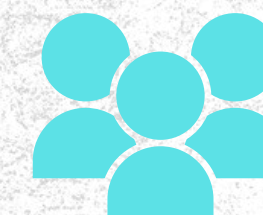


Such services are provided online throughout Ukraine.

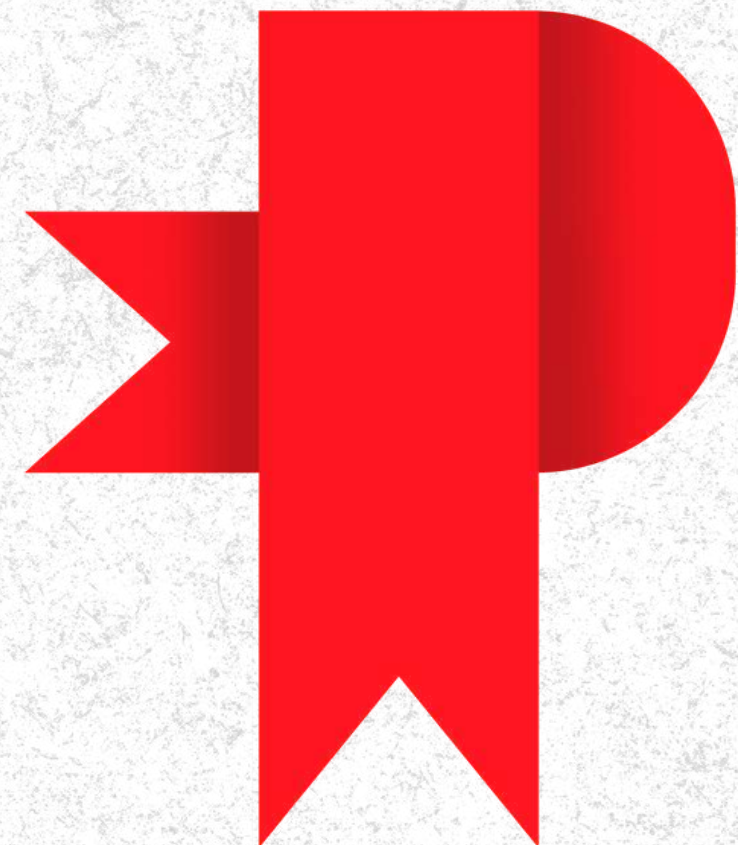
ADVOCACY AND HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION

An important **direction** is advocacy for changes in legislation and public policies to remove barriers to access to services and **guarantee equal rights and opportunities.**

PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" systematically worked to **protect the rights** of LGBTIQ+ communities and other most vulnerable communities facing discrimination and rights violations through the activities of the Paralegal Hub.

The organization provided **free paralegal assistance**, assisted in cases of persecution, discrimination, or denial of access to medical and social services.

There was also constant **cooperation with government agencies** and international partners to improve the legal situation of LGBTIQ+ and other communities in Ukraine.



PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" is the holder of **all networks** of paralegals of key communities and patient groups on HIV, and in particular in 2024 coordinated the work of 2 networks of paralegals: **MSM** (men who have sex with men) and **PLHIV** (people living with HIV).

MSM

Of the 116 recorded violations, 112 were completed "successfully" and rights were restored.

PLHIV

Of the 886 recorded appeals from the PLWHA community – people living with HIV, 640 appeals were completed "successfully", and rights were restored.

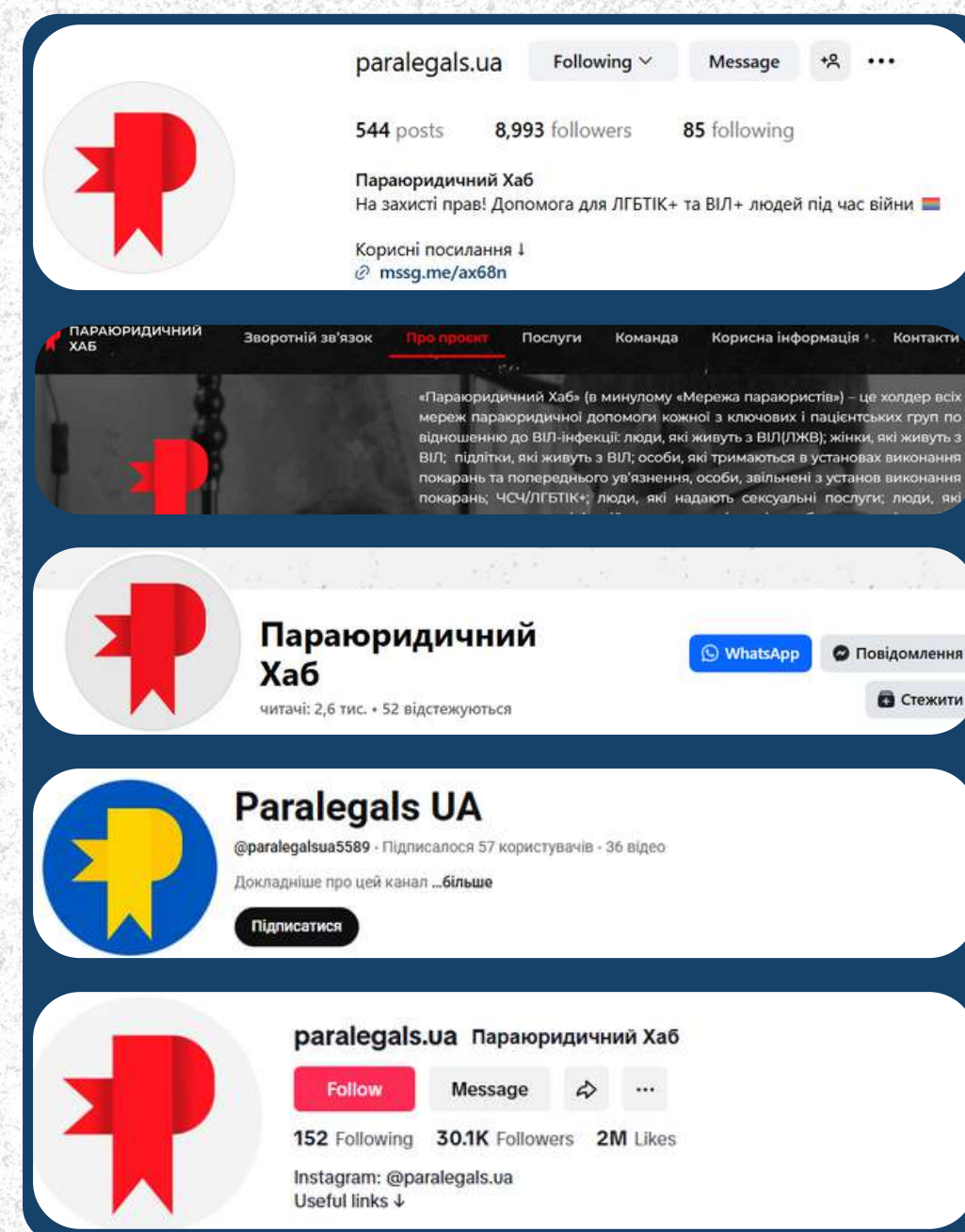

Mykhailo did not disclose his sexual orientation to his dormitory neighbors. But by chance they found his profile on social networks, where he openly wrote about himself.

Since then, passive aggression began: avoidance, neglect, a tense atmosphere, which made living together almost unbearable. This greatly affected his psychological state and sense of security in his own home.

The paralegal advised him to write a report to the commandant describing the situation and requesting that he talk to his neighbors and consider moving.

The administration granted the request: Mykhailo was transferred to another room, which helped to avoid further conflict and restore comfortable living conditions.

Monitoring hate speech in the media

Throughout 2024, the Paralegal Hub of PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" systematically monitored the Ukrainian media space for the presence of hate speech against the LGBTIQ+ community, people with HIV, people from ethnic minorities, people working in the sex industry, and other vulnerable categories.

The collected materials were analyzed for signs of hate speech, stereotypes, dehumanization, discriminatory language, and distortion of facts.

143

media materials contained signs of hate speech.

The highest level of homophobic material was recorded in May–June 2024, when media attention was focused on the Equality March and Pride Month.

Prevention of HIV and STIs

PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL has been implementing HIV and sexually transmitted infection (STI) prevention programs since 2003, combining counseling, testing, distribution of preventive materials (condoms, lubricants, information materials), tuberculosis screening, and testing for viral hepatitis and STIs.

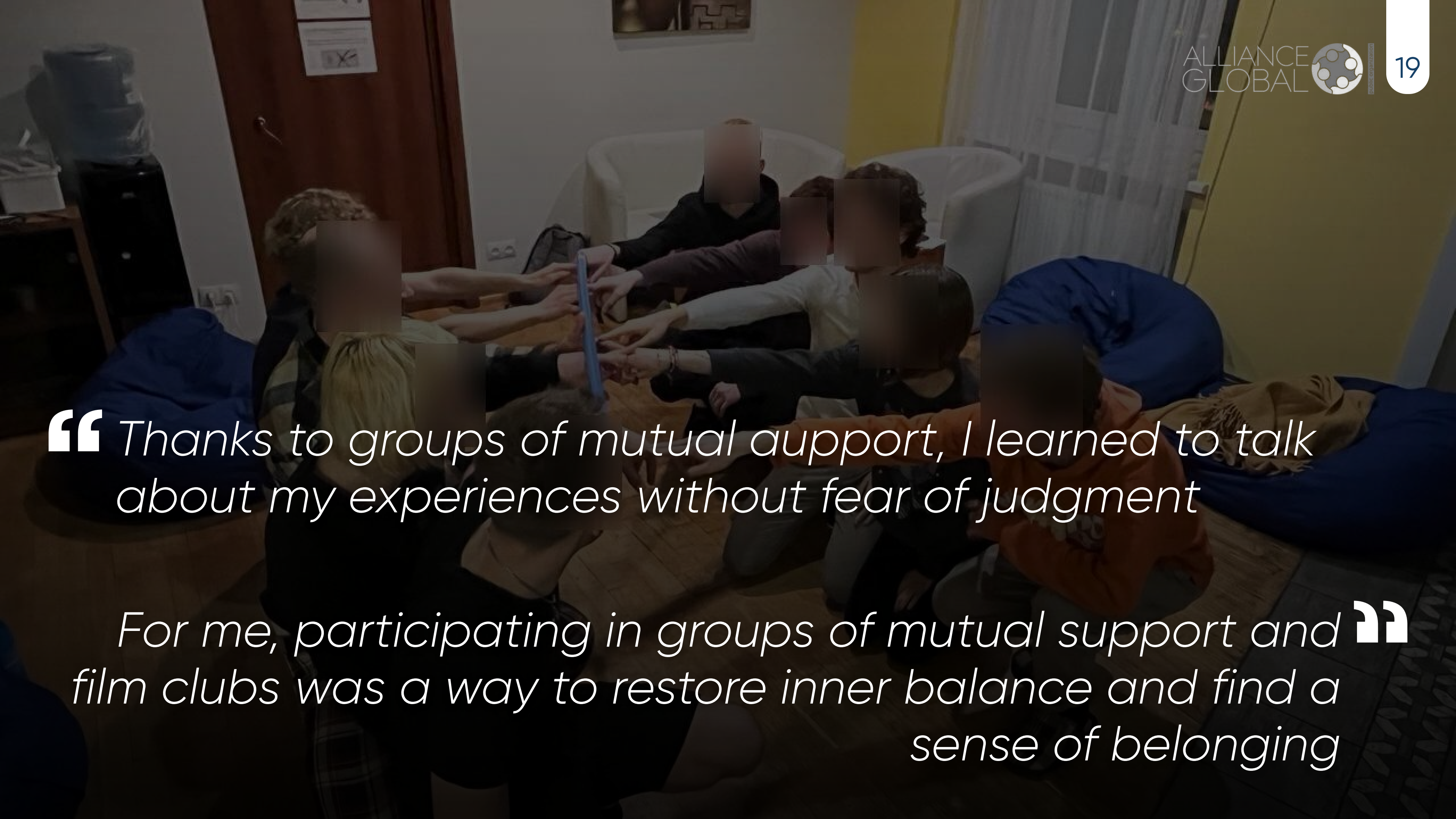

In 2024, the organization continued its work to expand access to assisted HIV self-testing and pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), allowing more people to learn their status on time, protect their health, and receive the support and treatment they need.

During 2024, a project **to conduct mutual support groups** for HIV+ MSM was implemented in Kyiv. Participants gathered and discussed the problems and peculiarities of living with HIV, health topics, discordant relationships, and other important issues. The project also provided **psychological counseling by a professional psychologist** for HIV+ MSM.

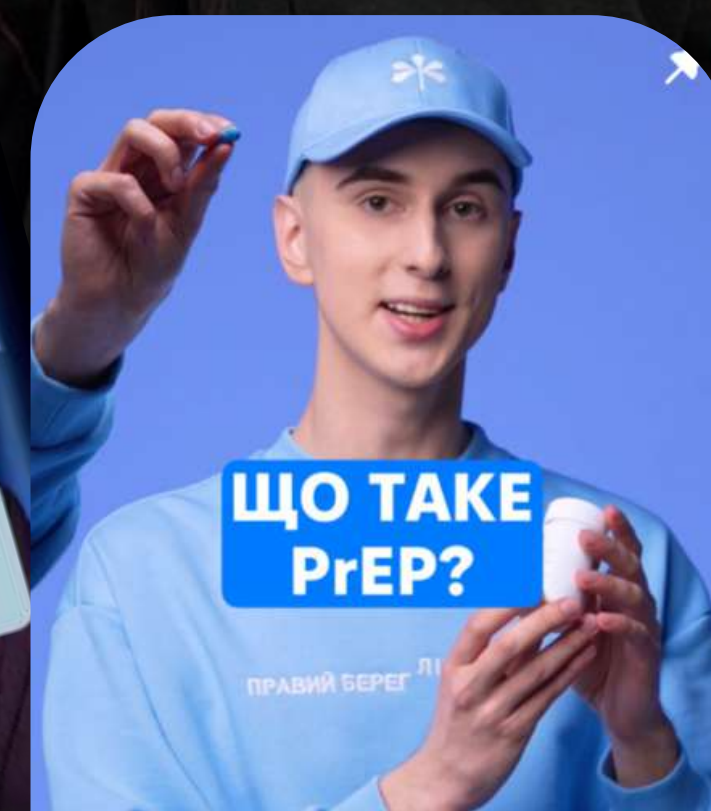

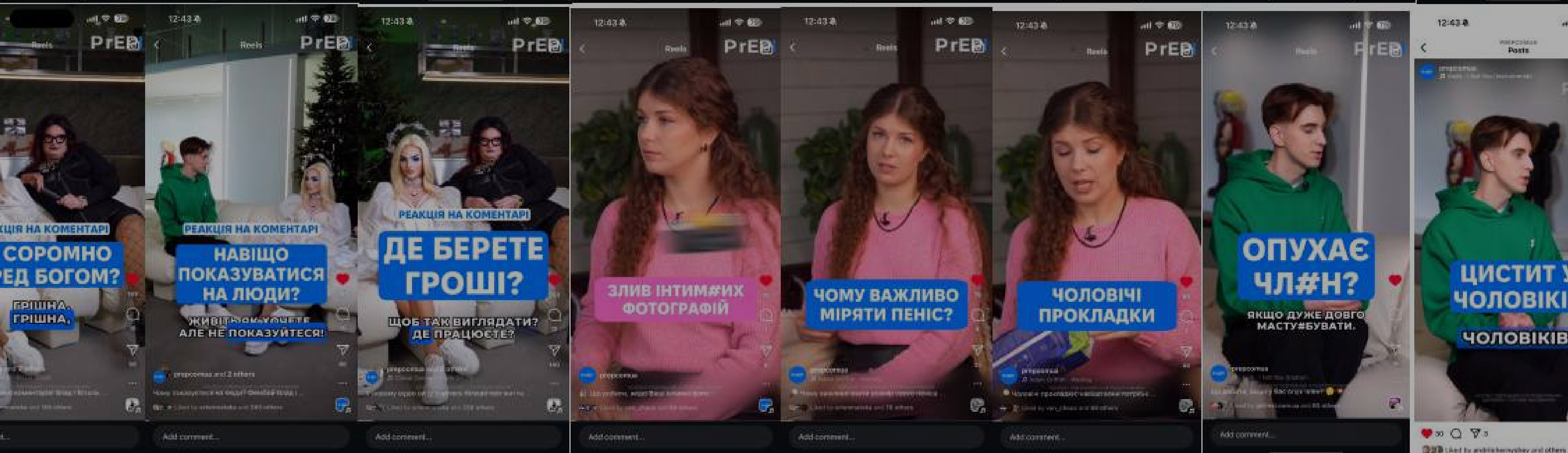
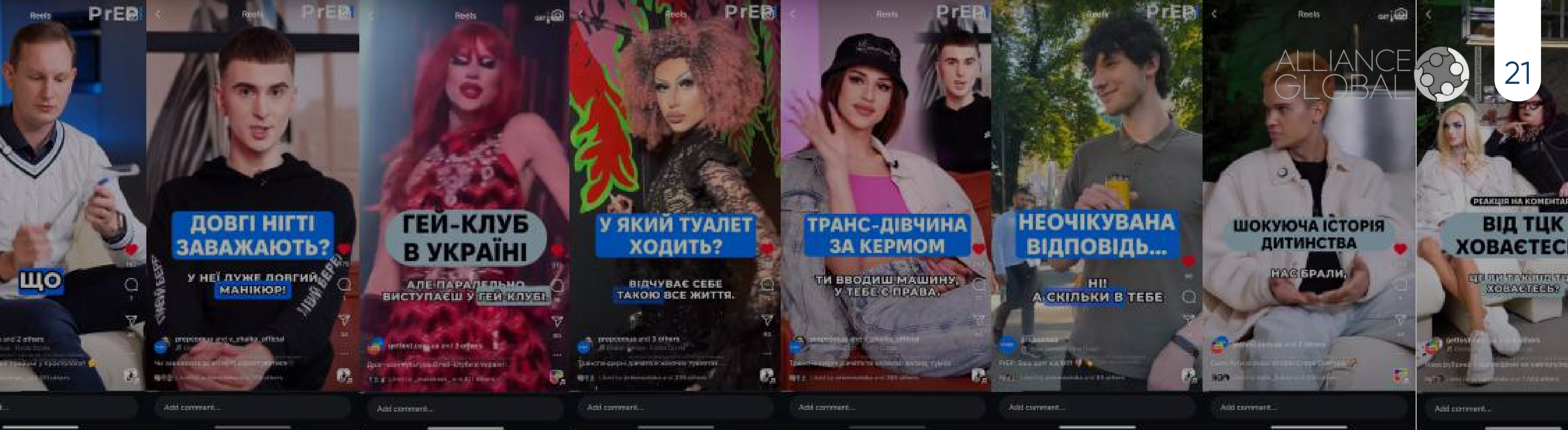
Get Test is a Ukrainian project that provides free, anonymous rapid testing for HIV, syphilis, and hepatitis B and C, with social support and peer-to-peer counseling, aimed at people who practice unprotected sex.

PrEP UA / prep.com.ua is a platform that provides information about HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and helps to obtain a free course of the drug for at-risk groups; the project is integrated into the national healthcare program.





MENTAL HEALTH
and psychosocial support

In 2024, the mental health and psychosocial support direction of PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" continued the dynamic development that began in 2023.

Thanks to the expansion of the team of specialists, institutional support of partners and increased trust from program participants, we were able to reach a larger number of people and offer more comprehensive services.

The main goal is to provide accessible psychological, psychiatric and social support for people experiencing crises, traumatic experiences or being in a vulnerable position.

HUMANITARIAN AID AND PROTECTION

In 2024, the Humanitarian Assistance and Protection direction of PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL was aimed at ensuring the basic needs and restoring a dignified life for program participants who had suffered from war and discrimination. The organization provided a wide range of services – from shelters, food and hygiene supplies, clothing and footwear, to psychological, medical, legal and paralegal support. A significant amount of activity was focused on winterization – the arrangement of safe spaces for LGBTIQ+ people in the winter and providing them with warm clothing and necessities. Particular attention was paid to psychosocial assistance, peer-to-peer consultations, educational initiatives and resocialization activities. The comprehensive approach allowed not only to cover urgent humanitarian needs, but also to contribute to the restoration of autonomy, stability and social integration of program participants.

In 2024, the network of shelters of PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL in Kyiv, Dnipro, Kharkiv, Lviv and Chernivtsi became a safe space for LGBTIQ+ people who had experienced violence, discrimination or lost their homes due to war. The shelters provided not only temporary free accommodation, but also comprehensive support – psychological, social, legal and medical. Teams of specialists helped residents restore emotional balance, access services, find employment and regain a sense of safety and dignity. For many, these spaces became the only place where they were accepted without judgment, where they could heal from traumatic experiences and feel part of the community again.

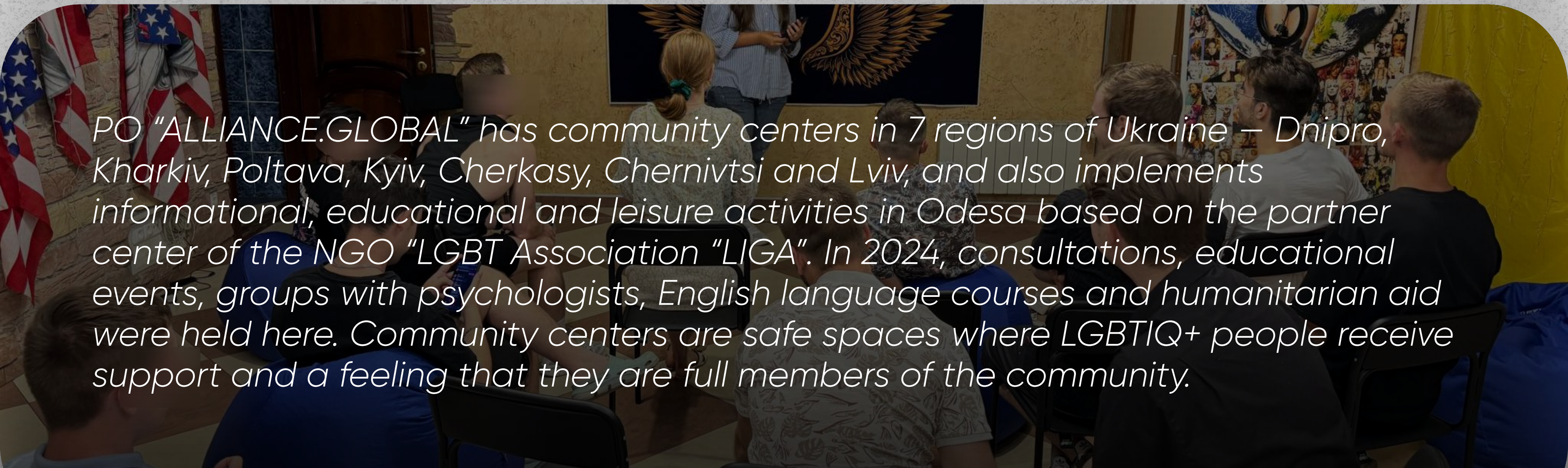

PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" has community centers in 7 regions of Ukraine – Dnipro, Kharkiv, Poltava, Kyiv, Cherkasy, Chernivtsi and Lviv, and also implements informational, educational and leisure activities in Odesa based on the partner center of the NGO "LGBT Association "LIGA". In 2024, consultations, educational events, groups with psychologists, English language courses and humanitarian aid were held here. Community centers are safe spaces where LGBTIQ+ people receive support and a feeling that they are full members of the community.

DEALING WITH CASES OF GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE (GBV)

In 2024, PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL team continued to provide comprehensive support to LGBTIQ+ people affected by gender-based violence, combining case management, psychosocial support, paralegal assistance, provision of safe shelter, educational trainings, information campaigns and advocacy against stigma and discrimination. Thanks to an interdisciplinary approach and coordination with friendly partners, victims were able to stabilize their emotional state, improve living conditions and restore their ability to self-sufficiency.

Physical violence: 4 cases
Emotional violence: 7 cases

Domestic physical and psychological violence by the family amounted to **7 cases**, which emphasizes the seriousness of the problem of **family rejection of LGBTIQ+ people**.



Homophobic incidents in public spaces were recorded **in 4 cases**, while outing at work, mobbing, and dismissal occurred **in 2 cases**.

Religious violence was also recorded **in 2 cases**.

Serhiy's story *(name changed for security reasons)*

He is a 19-year-old IDP who was denied housing and cash assistance. He received financial assistance to cover the first and last months of rent, which allowed him to move to a safe place. Thanks to employment support, he passed several interviews and found a job. Regular psychological counseling helped improve his emotional state, reduce anxiety, and restore interest in studies. A safety plan was developed with the possibility of emergency return to the shelter.

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" implemented activities aimed at increasing self-employment and financial independence of representatives of LGBTIQ+ communities through the development of professional skills. In 2024, the Organization provided a free opportunity to take professional courses to acquire a new specialty or retrain, as well as to attend English courses with experienced teachers based on "safe spaces" for LGBTIQ+ people. Such activities became an important tool of support in times of war, when many people lost their jobs or were forced to change their field of activity due to displacement.

XVII NATIONAL LGBTQ+ CONFERENCE

In December 2024, PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" together with other organizations of the National LGBTI Consortium organized the annual, 17th in a row, National LGBTQ+ Conference – the largest national communication platform for discussing and developing solutions in the areas of LGBTQ+ rights, national policy and advocacy, public health, regional community development, and humanitarian response in connection with the war. It brought together representatives of the non-governmental sector, state institutions, international partners, and donors to jointly identify development priorities, support, and strengthen advocacy efforts in the context of the war and European integration.

Educational activities

In 2024, PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" developed an author's training "Inclusion, Diversity, Equality and Accessibility in Working with LGBTIQ+ Communities" for partner NGOs. The training is dedicated to raising awareness about effective and sensitive interaction with LGBTIQ+ communities.
