





WHAT DOES ALLIANCE.GLOBAL DO?

Currently, over more than 3 years of armed conflict, the NGO “Alliance.Global” has been providing the following types of services to LGBTIQ+ individuals who have found themselves in difficult life circumstances due to the war:

Shelters for LGBTIQ+ individuals in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Dnipro, and Lviv

Community center-based services for those in vulnerable life circumstances due to the war, available in Kyiv, Lviv, Poltava, Cherkasy, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi, and Odesa

Multipurpose individual cash assistance in Government-controlled areas of Ukraine

Humanitarian aid: food and hygiene vouchers, clothing, footwear, mobile accessories, and more

Psychological support: individual and group counseling, psychiatric consultations, and reimbursement for prescription antidepressants

Professional training, including English language courses and online AI skills development

Legal and para-legal assistance, along with medical consultations


Peer-to-peer consultations on GBV (gender-based violence) issues and direct referral to relevant programs/projects; case management of GBV among LGBTIQ+ individuals

The chart illustrates regional activity related to the provision of temporary shelter for LGBTIQ+ people **during 2025**.









As part of the program's activities, beneficiaries received essential humanitarian aid, including:


- Vouchers for basic necessities







Challenges in access to services for LGBTIQ+ communities:

1. Humanitarian aid concentrates on frontline areas, while LGBTIQ+ communities live throughout Ukraine;
2. Humanitarian organizations need training on the specifics of working with LGBTIQ+;
3. Discriminatory practices limit access to state support;
4. Reduction in international donor funding;
5. High levels of burnout and staff turnover in wartime conditions.



Proposals for ensuring sustainability and quality of services for LGBTIQ+ communities:

1. Training for NGOs and state institutions on inclusive work with LGBTIQ+;
2. Strengthening the influence of local organizations through partnerships and localization;
3. Flexible funding that accounts for the geography of needs and force majeure circumstances;
4. Strengthening organizational capacity of LGBTIQ+ NGOs for long-term sustainability;
5. Burnout prevention and experience exchange between organizations.
