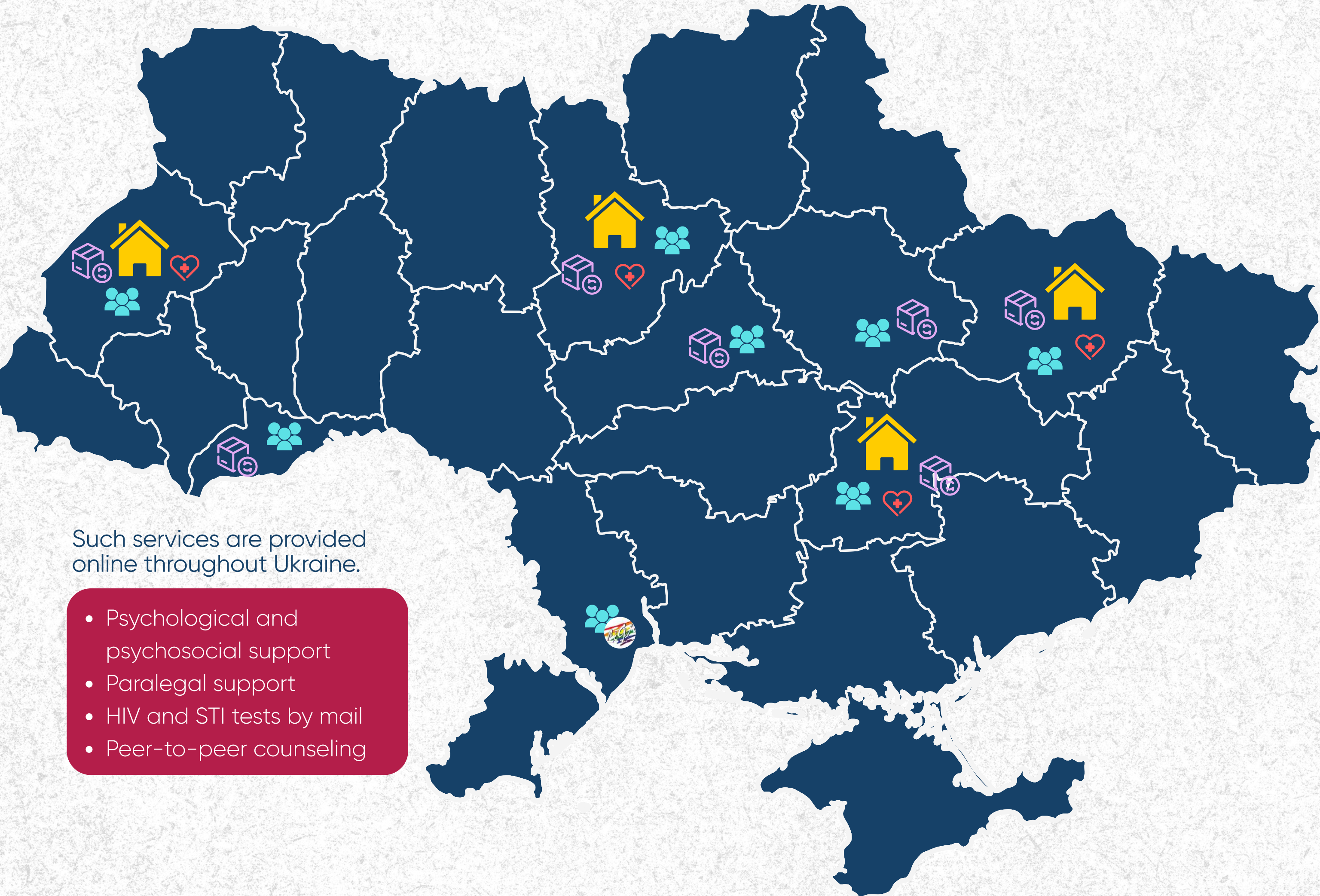


# About us

ALLIANCE.GLOBAL, Public Organization (hereinafter PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL") **specializes** in protecting human rights and promoting the reduction of homo-, bi-, and transphobia in Ukrainian society; providing services for HIV/AIDS, viral hepatitis, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) among men who have sex with men (MSM), and is focused on **the development and consolidation of the LGBTIQ+ community.**

Officially registered in **October 2002**



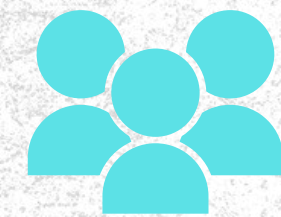

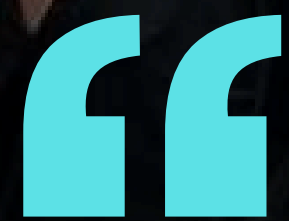

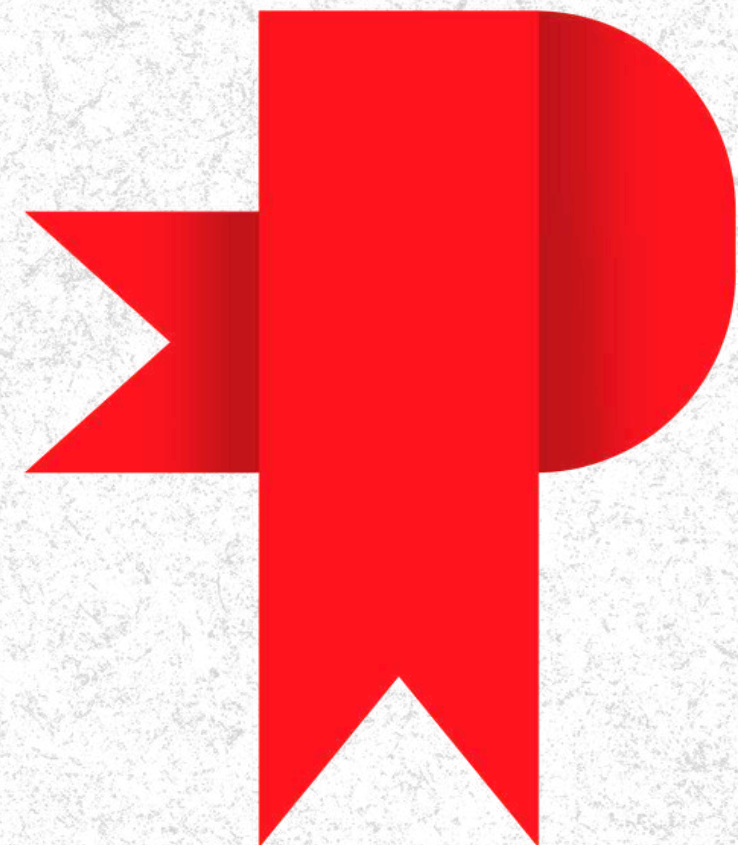
# ADVOCACY AND HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION

*An important **direction** is advocacy for changes in legislation and public policies to remove barriers to access to services and **guarantee equal rights and opportunities.***

PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" systematically worked to **protect the rights** of LGBTIQ+ communities and other most vulnerable communities facing discrimination and rights violations through the activities of the Paralegal Hub.

The organization provided **free paralegal assistance**, assisted in cases of persecution, discrimination, or denial of access to medical and social services.

There was also constant **cooperation with government agencies** and international partners to improve the legal situation of LGBTIQ+ and other communities in Ukraine.



PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" is the holder of **all networks** of paralegals of key communities and patient groups on HIV, and in particular in 2025 coordinated the work of 2 networks of paralegals: **MSM** (men who have sex with men) and **PLHIV** (people living with HIV).

**MSM**

A total of 327 appeals were recorded, of which 306 appeals – 94% – were completed "successfully," and rights were restored; lawyers worked on 39 appeals.

**PLHIV**

Of the 886 recorded appeals from the PLWHA community – people living with HIV – 640 appeals were completed "successfully," and rights were restored.

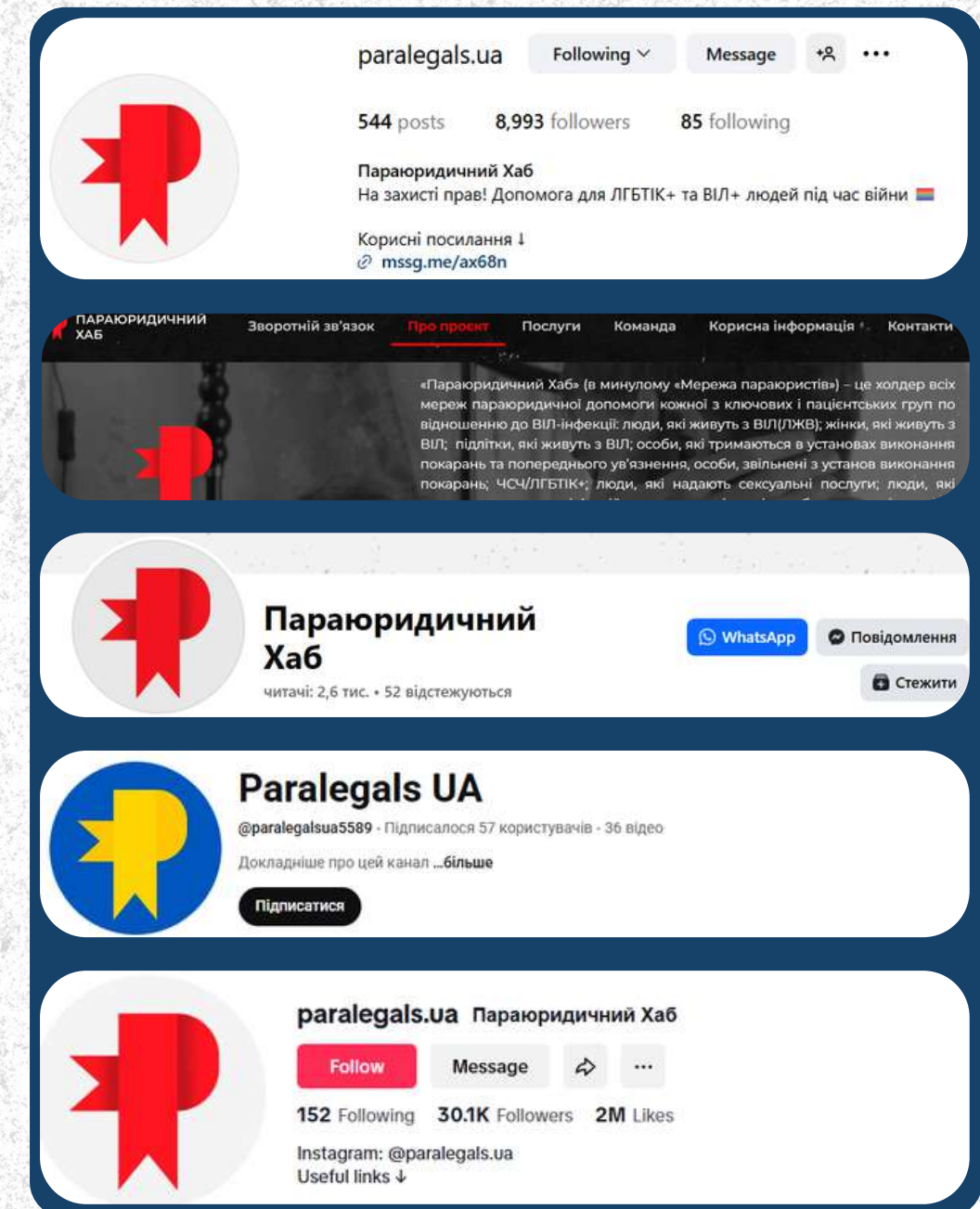

*Yaroslav worked as a barista in a coffee shop, where he was valued by colleagues and regular guests. But after the management found out about his HIV status, they hinted that it would be “better to resign voluntarily.”*

*Yaroslav turned to a paralegal. She explained that this was discrimination and helped him prepare an appeal to the coffee shop owner with references to legislation.*

*After reviewing the situation, Yaroslav was allowed to stay at work, and a short training session on equal treatment of people living with HIV was conducted for the staff.*

*Later, he became the administrator of the same coffee shop and says that this story taught him to defend his own dignity.*

## Monitoring hate speech in the media

In 2025, the organization carried out systematic monitoring of the Ukrainian media space **to identify hate speech**, discriminatory narratives, and stigmatizing rhetoric regarding MSM (men who have sex with men) and, more broadly, the LGBTQ+ community.

The results showed that professional Ukrainian media generally demonstrate a more restrained and responsible approach; however, in social networks and in public statements by political, religious, and far-right figures, the risks of spreading hate speech remain.

A particularly noticeable transformation has been the shift from aggressive rhetoric to more veiled forms of discrimination – through appeals to “traditional values,” morality, religion, or manipulative sensationalism.

## NATIONAL LGBTIQ+ ADVOCACY

PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" is one of the four organizations of the National LGBTI Consortium #LGBTI\_PRO, which works to achieve civil equality, inclusive attitudes towards LGBTIQ+ people, and ensure access to HIV services for key groups, primarily MSM (men who have sex with men).

# Prevention of HIV and STIs

PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL has been implementing HIV and sexually transmitted infection (STI) prevention programs since 2003, combining counseling, testing, distribution of preventive materials (condoms, lubricants, information materials), tuberculosis screening, and testing for viral hepatitis and STIs.

In 2025, the organization continued its work to expand access to assisted HIV self-testing and pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), allowing more people to learn their status on time, protect their health, and receive the support and treatment they need.

# MENTAL HEALTH

*and psychosocial support*

In 2025, we continued comprehensive support for the mental health of members of the LGBTQ+ community, which has been significantly affected by the full-scale war in Ukraine and the specific challenges related to identity.

Our activities focused on ensuring a safe space where each beneficiary could receive qualified assistance – from overcoming crisis conditions to long-term therapeutic support and psychiatric care.

# HUMANITARIAN AID AND PROTECTION

Throughout 2025, the organization continued to ensure the stable operation of a network of shelters in four of Ukraine's largest cities: Kyiv, Kharkiv, Dnipro, and Lviv. The project was aimed at providing comprehensive assistance to the most vulnerable members of the LGBTQ+ community who found themselves in difficult life circumstances due to the war or discrimination. Special attention was given to members of the trans\* and non-binary community, for whom the shelters became a safe place during the lengthy process of changing documents, as well as protection from aggressive societal rejection.

The shelters were also actively used by members of the MSM community, who needed not only housing but also a safe environment to find like-minded people and restore their inner resources.

In addition to providing shelter, a key aspect of the work was the socialization of residents. Monthly mandatory group activities with professional psychologists were held in each shelter. These meetings were aimed at fostering communication within groups, preventing conflicts, and improving social cohesion. Each resident also had access to HIV prevention services, testing, and consultations regarding the use of PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis).

Pavlo evacuated from dangerous Zaporizhzhia. Having lost his job and housing, he turned to the Kyiv shelter. In addition to a roof over his head, he received psychological support that helped him find work as a barista. Today, Pavlo is fully financially independent and rents his own home.

*PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" has community centers in 7 regions of Ukraine – Dnipro, Kharkiv, Poltava, Kyiv, Cherkasy, Chernivtsi and Lviv, and also implements informational, educational and leisure activities in Odesa based on the partner center of the NGO "LGBT Association "LIGA". In 2025, consultations, educational events, groups with psychologists, English language courses and humanitarian aid were held here. Community centers are safe spaces where LGBTIQ+ people receive support and a feeling that they are full members of the community.*

# DEALING WITH CASES OF GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE (GBV)

In 2025, PO ALLIANCE.GLOBAL team continued to provide comprehensive support to LGBTIQ+ people affected by gender-based violence, combining case management, psychosocial support, paralegal assistance, provision of safe shelter, educational trainings, information campaigns and advocacy against stigma and discrimination. Thanks to an interdisciplinary approach and coordination with friendly partners, victims were able to stabilize their emotional state, improve living conditions and restore their ability to self-sufficiency.

Domestic physical and psychological violence by the family, which emphasizes the seriousness of the problem of **family rejection of LGBTIQ+ people.**



## **Alexander's Story** *(name changed for safety)*

A 22-year-old master's student, due to physical violence from his partner and threats to disclose information about his sexual orientation, was forced to leave his home and seek help. After being placed in a safe shelter, he received comprehensive support that allowed him to stabilize his security situation, begin psychological therapy, obtain financial assistance, and find a job – all of which contributed to improving his emotional state and overall life circumstances.

At the time the case was closed, there was no direct contact with the abuser, the situation remained stable, and the client demonstrated a higher level of independence and resilience.

# ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

In 2025, the organization developed the area of digital education, in particular training on the basics of artificial intelligence on the Coursera platform. The program gave participants the opportunity to better understand how modern AI tools work and how they can be used in work, study, or everyday tasks.

Also in 2025, the BLOOM program was launched, aimed at supporting the economic resilience of community members through the development, recovery, or adaptation of microbusinesses. Participants had the chance to strengthen their entrepreneurial activities in various fields – from services, education, and IT to manufacturing, retail, and agriculture. The program helped create or preserve sources of income for individuals and households in frontline and war-affected regions.

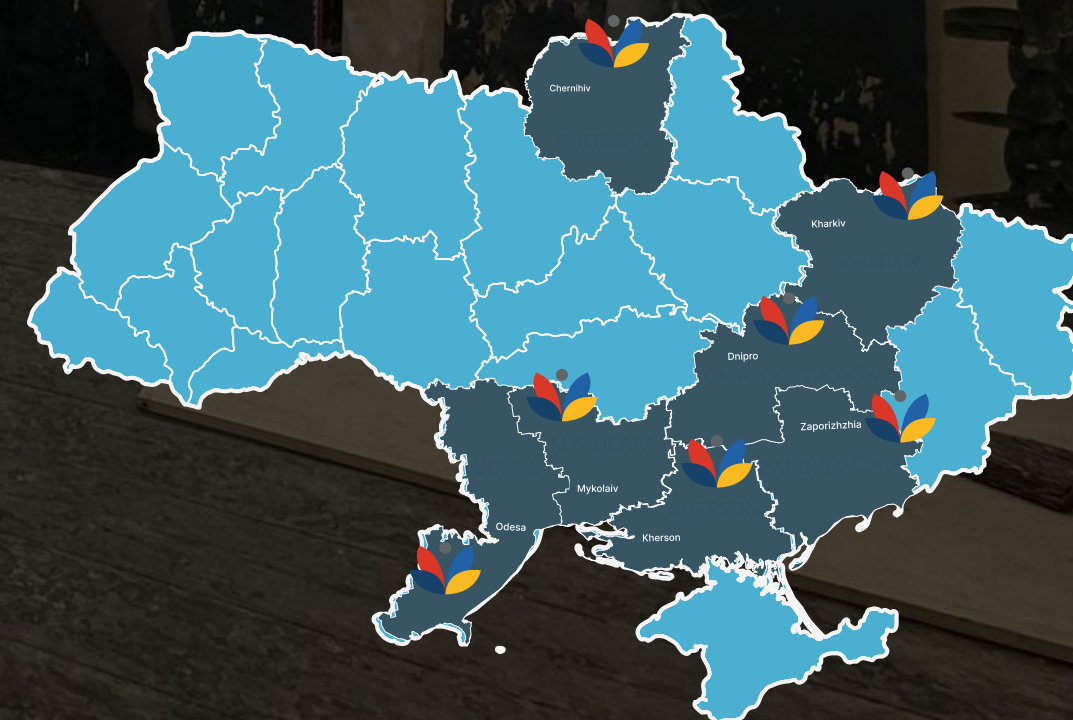

# XVIII NATIONAL LGBTIQ+ CONFERENCE

In November 2025, NGO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL," together with other organizations of the National LGBTI Consortium, organized the annual 18th consecutive National LGBTQ+ Conference – the largest national communication platform for discussing and developing solutions in the areas of LGBTQ+ rights, national policy and advocacy, public health, regional community development, and humanitarian response in connection with the war. The conference brought together representatives of the non-governmental sector, state institutions, international partners, and donors to jointly define development priorities, provide support, and strengthen advocacy efforts in the context of war and European integration.

# Educational activities

In 2025, PO "ALLIANCE.GLOBAL" developed an author's training "Inclusion, Diversity, Equality and Accessibility in Working with LGBTIQ+ Communities" for partner NGOs. The training is dedicated to raising awareness about effective and sensitive interaction with LGBTIQ+ communities.
